## ACCOMMODATION HOMESTAY

At ACE we recognise that accommodation is a very important part of your stay in Australia. Each ACE campus has its own accommodation office, staffed by experienced accommodation officers who can help you with all your accommodation needs.

ACE offers various types of accommodation for its students.

Most students at ACE stay with an Australian family in 'homestay' accommodation, which is offered at all ACE campuses. Homestay accommodation is a fantastic introduction to Australian life. Living in an Australian home allows students to practice English, learn about life and customs in Australia and make new friends.



Homestay accommodation includes half-board (breakfast and dinner) Monday to Friday, and full-board (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) on weekends. All ACE homestays are located a maximum of 35 minutes travel time from the campus, and close to public transport. ACE takes great care in selecting families, to ensure that they are friendly and caring, and provide an excellent standard of facilities for students.

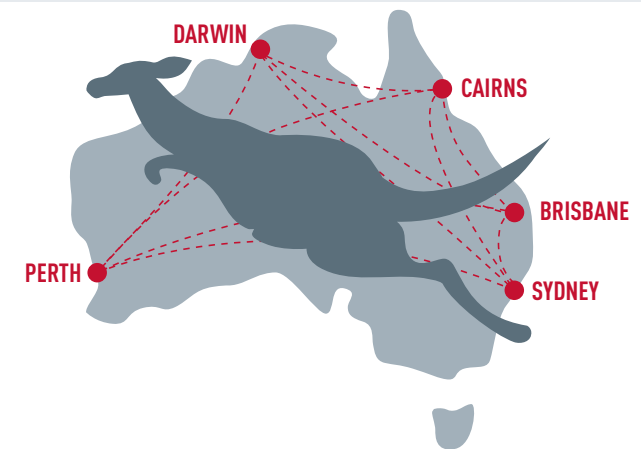
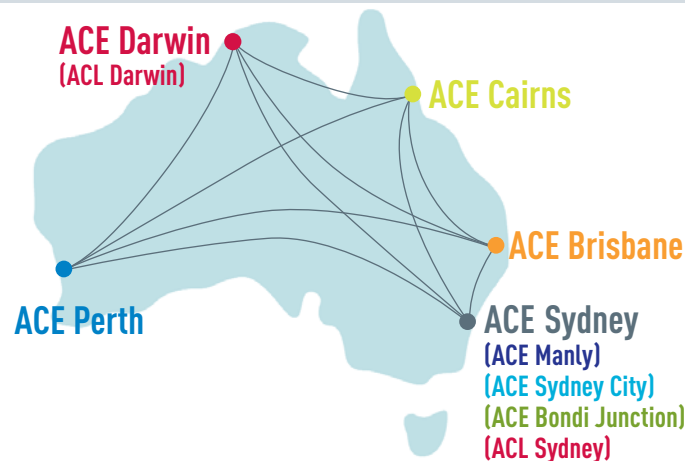

## 1. Cancellation Policy

For the purposes of this policy a course is defined as the number of modules/weeks that have been prepaid for tuition at any campus of ACE. The College guarantees to conform to the Refund Policy and Code of Ethics of English Australia. The Enrolment Fee is payable once only and is not refundable.

### Tuition

- At least 4 weeks written notice prior to commencement of the course, full refund.
- Less than 4 weeks written notice prior to commencement of the course, a cancellation charge equal to the first 4 weeks of tuition will apply.
- No refund is payable after you have commenced studying at The College.
- If visa application has been denied, a full refund of tuition fees and accommodation fees (if a placement has not been made) will be made provided The College receives a copy of the Australian Embassy rejection letter.
- The College reserves the right to expel students for serious breaches of discipline. Where an expelled student has enrolled in a course greater than 20 weeks and has taken up less than the 20 weeks of the course, 40% of prepaid fees will be refunded in respect of remaining course weeks greater than 20 weeks.
- Students who transfer to university studies, and who have met the university's English entry requirements, are eligible for a refund on the unused portion of English studies less a cancellation fee of 25% of those fees.
