Visa Information

Student Visa If you wish to study in Australia for more than 12 weeks, you need to apply for a student visa. While on a student visa you must study in a full-time course and be covered by Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). Once you arrive in Australia you may apply for Work Permission, which allows you to work up to 20 hours per week while studying.

Tourist/Visitor Visa If you plan to study in Australia for 12 weeks or less, you can apply for a tourist/visitor visa. Tourist/visitor visas do not allow you to undertake paid employment.

Working Holiday Visa If you come to Australia on a working holiday visa, you may study for a maximum of 12 weeks.

Special Programs Visa allows entry of up to 12 months for Internship applicants.

Homestay and Airport Pickup

Please read the following conditions carefully and contact enguiry@acl.edu.au if you need any further information:

- Enrolment, Accommodation Placement and Airport Pick-up fees are not refundable.
- 2 Tuition fees are refundable in full if a visa application is rejected and the official Embassy rejection advice is made available to ACL. Cancellation and refund requests to ACL should be made immediately after receipt of the visa rejection advice and in writing
- 3. If you cancel your enrolment more than 28 days before your start date, then all tuition fees will be refunded. All cancellation requests should be made in writing.
- If you cancel your enrolment less than 28 days before your start date, then 75% of the 4 tuition fees will be refunded, subject to a maximum cancellation fee of 12 weeks' tuition fees. All cancellation requests should be made in writing.
- If you cancel your enrolment on or after your start date the tuition fees will not be refunded or transferred.
- 6. Refunds are not paid direct to you in Australia but in your home country, and will be paid within one month of receipt by ACL of the written cancellation request. If you enrol through a representative, the refund will be paid through that representative.
- Where ACL cancels or defers a course, all fees will be refunded. In such cases refunds 7 are not paid to you in Australia but in your home country, and will be paid within two weeks of the day on which the course ceased to be provided. If you enrol through a representative, the refund will be paid through that representative. Where possible, and at no obligation, a suitable alternative course will be offered as an alternative to a refund of tuition fees
- 8. If you cancel your homestay request with less than 4 weeks' notice you may be liable for payment of the first 2 weeks. You are required to give 2 weeks' notice if you wish to cancel your homestay after commencement. Special cancellation fees may apply for other accommodation arrangements. An \$80 amendment fee applies to all changes made to accommodation bookings after the commencement of the course.

- Student visa holders unable to attend classes due to illness will be marked as absent. 2 Therefore, students must obtain a medical certificate from a registered practitioner and keep all the medical certificates to present to DIMIA if required.
- 3. Student visa holders are required to provide ACL with current Sydney residential address and telephone number at all times.
- 4. ACL students are required to follow Government requirements for international students and obev Australian law
- 5. ACL students are expected to behave in a courteous and considerate manner towards ACL staff and other students.
- 6. No smoking is allowed on ACL premises.
- 7. All due care is to be taken with ACL equipment, facilities and property.
- 8. ACL students who breach these rules may be:
 - · asked to leave ACL premises
 - · reported to the relevant Government department
 - · required to pay for damages caused
