1. Notification of cancellation or withdrawal from individual courses or a packaged program must be made in writing to Shafston prior to the start date of the packaged program.
2. Application and Accommodation Placement fees are not refundable.
3. Cancellation in writing at least 4 weeks before the student's original packaged program start date attracts a full refund of fees paid except as in points 2 and 6.
4. Cancellation in writing less than 4 weeks before the student's original packaged program start date attracts a refund except as in points 2 and 6 and less a \$500 cancellation fee per course.
