How to Enrol

1. Student Visa

- For student visa students from countries where a Pre-Visa Assessment (PVA) is not required - Send a completed enrolment form and on receipt of invoice appropriate fees to your GEOS Cairns Representative or direct to GEOS Cairns.
- For students from countries where a PVA is required Apply to the Australian Embassy in your country before enrolling with GEOS Send completed enrolment form and appropriate fees together with your original PVA letter to GEOS Cairns. Upon receipt of these documents, we will send you a receipt and the Confirmation on Enrolment (CoE) This is needed for your student visa application.

2. Tourist or Working Holiday Visa

Complete the enrolment form and send it together with the appropriate fees to your GEOS Cairns Representative or direct to GEOS Cairns. Upon receipt we will send you confirmation.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- A Course Cancellation is not effective until it is received by GEOS Cairns in writing.
- The Enrolment fee is not refundable
- All fees except the Enrolment fee will be refunded if you are not granted a visa.
- If you cancel your course MORE than 28 days before your course commencement date all fees, except the Enrolment charge will be refunded.
- If you cancel your course LESS than 28 days before your course commencement date a cancellation fee of 25% of tuition fees will apply.
- No tuition fees will be refunded if you advise cancellation on or after vour course commencement date.
- The Homestay placement charge and/or airport pickup charge are not refundable if you advise GEOS Cairns less that two weeks before your commencement date that you will not be using this service.
- Where GEOS Cairns terminates or does not offer a course and is unable to offer a course, such situations are covered by the provisions of the ESOS Act 2000 and the ESOS Regulations 2001. You will be refunded the full amount of fees that you have paid to GEOS Cairns within two weeks.
- GEOS Cairns reserves the right to expel a student who is in breach of the Australian Government visa requirements, or does not adhere to the discipline code of the College. In such cases no refund will be
- GEOS Cairns reserves the right to change its fees, conditions, course times, timetables, class locations, class size and course commencement at any time without notice.
- Study days lost due to late commencement on courses are not recoverable. There are no refunds for public holidays or absences occurring during your course.
- Should the student cancel their enrolment, the College shall effect the necessary refund within 4 weeks. The refund will be paid directly to the person who entered into the contract with GEOS Cairns, unless the person gives written direction to pay someone else. The refund will be paid in the same currency in which the fees were paid unless this is impracticable.
- The College's dispute resolution process does not circumscribe the student's right to pursue other legal remedies, nor does this agreement remove the right to take further action under the Australian consumer protection laws.
