IELTS Exam Preparation	Students can start on any Monday. Recommended start dates are 31 December ('07), 10 March, 19 May, 28 July & 6 October 2008 (10 week terms). Entry into this course requires satisfactory evidence of upper intermediate or above English proficiency and on student passing the Preliminary IELTS Entrance Exam. Course fees exclude the Exam Fee (students to arrange) and a compulsory/ancillary fee of \$110 (1 course book and 1 work book). Students will receive a refund of \$50 on return of their course book.

REFUND POLICY (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

ENROLMENT AND ACCOMMODATION PLACEMENT FEES

Enrolment and Homestay Placement Fees are non-refundable.

HOMESTAY FEES

If written cancellation is received 14 days prior to your arrival at the Homestay a full refund of unused fees is available. If your visa application is rejected your Homestay payment will be refunded in full. If you cancel your accommodation request once you are in your homestay, a minimum of two weeks' rent is to be paid. You must give at least two weeks' notice if you wish to change your accommodation. Student flight details must be received to begin the placement process. Once flight details are received, the Homestay placement service may take up to 10 working days.

AIRPORT PICKUP FEES

If written cancellation is received 7 days prior to airport pickup a full refund of unused fees is available. If your visa application is rejected, your Airport Transfer payment will be refunded in full. If your airline flight details change, please give us as much notice as possible. If you give us less than 24 hours notice, you will incur another airport transfer fee.

TUITION FEES

If the required visa is not granted, a full refund of tuition fees will be made, provided that sufficient evidence of visa refusal is given to the college by the refusing Australian Authority.

If the college receives written notice of cancellation of enrolment 28 days prior to the course commencement, a full refund of tuition fees will be paid. If the college receives written notice of cancellation less than 28 days prior to the course commencement, a refund of 75% of tuition fees will be paid.

If the college receives written notice of cancellation on or within four weeks of the course commencement, then the student is entitled to a refund of 30% of the tuition fees. Once 50% of the course is completed, no refund is available.

If you make changes to your course after you have started, you are required to provide a minimum of 4 weeks notice (ie. transfers, deferrals or early course completions).

Any refunds will be paid within 4 weeks of receipt of written application. All refunds will be made in the currency in Australian dollars (except where this is impractical) and directly to the person who entered into the contract, unless written authorisation is received from that person, requesting payment of a refund to another party.

In the unlikely event that GEOS Gold Coast is unable to deliver your course in full, you will be offered a refund of all the course money you have paid to date. The refund will be paid to you within 2 weeks of the day on which the course ceased being provided. Alternatively, you may be offered enrolment in a suitable alternative course by GEOS Gold Coast at no extra cost to you. You have the right to choose whether you would prefer a full refund of course fees, or to accept a place in another course. If you choose placement in another course, we will ask you to sign a document to indicate that you accept the placement. If GEOS Gold Coast is unable to provide a refund or place you in an alternative course our Tuition Assurance Scheme (TAS) English Australia will place you in a suitable alternative course at no extra cost to you. Finally, if English Australia cannot place you in a suitable alternative course, the ESOS Assurance Fund Manager will attempt to place you in a suitable alternative course or, if this is not possible, you will be eligible for a refund as calculated by the Fund Manager.

In the case of a refund being made to a student, in accordance with the conditions above, any portion of tuition fees collected by an education agent will be refunded by the agent, as per the terms and conditions of GEOS Gold Coast's Agreement. Any such refund is calculated as a proportion of the tuition fees, based on the commission originally received by the education agent and the amount being returned to the student, in accordance with the above conditions.

GENERAL

Any specials applied to the original enrolment will take place at the end of the course. If, due to exceptional circumstances, such as serious illness or bereavement, a monetary credit for study weeks is granted, it will include only paid weeks remaining and will be valid for a period of 12 months from the date of issue.

GEOS Gold Coast will not accept students under the age of 18 years of age (except on a study tour or in the Young Learners Program).

INFORMATION DISCLAIMER

GEOS Gold Coast's dispute resolution processes do not circumscribe your right to pursue other legal remedies. You are also given the right to be represented by a nominee if you so choose. This agreement, and the availability of complaints and appeals processes, does not remove the right to take further action under Australian Consumer Protection laws.

Australian Law requires student visa holders to inform GEOS Gold Coast of any change of address within 7 days and other changes thereafter. Student details may be made available to Commonwealth and State agencies and the Fund Manager of the ESOS Assurance Fund pursuant to obligations under the ESOS Act 2000 and the National Code. The provider is required under S19 of the ESOS Act 2000 to tell the department of:

- (i) certain changes to the student's enrolment
- (ii) any breach by the student of a student visa condition relating to attendance or satisfactory academic performance.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (please read carefully)

- o I have read and understand the terms of GEOS Gold Coast's Refund Policy.
- o I understand that some courses require a prerequisite level of English language proficiency for entry.
- o I understand that I will be tested on or before the commencement of my course, and placed in an appropriate English language level.
- o I understand that I must complete all class work, assignments, activities and assessments in order to maintain satisfactory progress.
- o I understand that I must attend at least 80% of my English course, and that if I fail to do so, I may be reported to the Australian Government.
- o I understand that I must inform GEOS Gold Coast immediately if I change my address in Australia.
- o I understand that I cannot change my school during the course without a written letter of release from GEOS Gold Coast.
- o I have read the regulations of the college and agree to abide by them.
- o I am aware that school age dependents accompanying me will be required to pay full at a private or government school in Australia.
- o I understand that my personal information may be shared with the Australian Government, designated authorities, the Tuition Assurance Scheme, and the ESOS Assurance Fund Manager. This information may include personal and contact details, course enrolment details and changes, and circumstances of any suspected breach by the student of a student visa condition.
- o I agree that GEOS Gold Coast can share information about my course and my progress with my parents, recruiting agent and government agencies as required.
- o I acknowledge that GEOS Gold Coast has the right to change its fees and conditions, cancel or defer courses, and to alter course timetables and class locations at any time without notice.
