All students are required to attend orientation. Please note that if you miss the course commencement date you may not be able to access the English level of your first choice. INSEARCH closes on Australian public holidays and for two weeks at Christmas. There is a two week break between every 15 week semester of Academic courses. The above course lengths indicate minimum duration. Applications for full-time English courses are only accepted for the full five week terms as per the published dates.

INTERNATIONAL CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT-IMPORTANT:

Please read these before you sign the application form

- INSEARCH and the University of Technology, Sydney (UTS)**
 - All courses are offered by INSEARCH Limited ABN-39 001 425 065 (CRICOS provider code: 00859D) (INSEARCH). INSEARCH is a controlled entity of the University of Technology, Sydney. Students are enrolled as students of INSEARCH and not of UTS.
- Package programs**
 - International students may be offered a package program, which consists of an English language course and an Academic course. Students must satisfactorily complete the English language course before proceeding to the Academic course.
 - A student may be required to repeat the English language course if they did not complete it satisfactorily. The student will be required to pay an additional fee for the repeat course.
- Attendance**
 - Australian government regulations state that it is a condition of a student visa that a student must attend 80% of the course.
- International student processing fee and course fees**
 - Course fees must be paid at least 28 days before the first day of each course.
 - International students who have not studied full-time with INSEARCH before must also pay a one-off international student processing fee.
 - Fees must be paid in Australian dollars by bank cheque, bank draft, cash or credit card. INSEARCH will not be responsible for any monies paid to agents.
 - INSEARCH reserves the right to vary fees and/or course dates at any time.
 - The international student processing fee and course fees do not cover the cost of accommodation, living expenses, textbooks, stationery or other equipment.
- Course duration and additional fees**
 - A course commences on the first day of orientation of the course.
 - If a student defers their course after payment of tuition, the course commencement date is the first day of orientation of the course in which the student had originally enrolled.
 - Students will be advised of the course duration prior to enrolment. Students who require extra semesters to complete their course will be required to pay additional fees.
- Change of address**
 - Students are required by government legislation to immediately notify INSEARCH Student Services of any changes of address while enrolled in the program.
- Accommodation**
 - INSEARCH requires 28 days' notice to arrange homestay and airport welcome service. Additional terms and conditions and fees apply. Accommodation booking fees and airport welcome fees are not refundable under any circumstances.
- Students who wish to use the UTS housing list must pay a fee of \$75 on arrival. This must be paid directly to the UTS housing office when applying for this service and not INSEARCH.
- Cancellation and refunds**
 - The international student processing fee will be refunded to students only if INSEARCH cancels the course the student is enrolled in and will not be refunded under any other circumstances.
 - Course fees and homestay fees will be refunded only in the following circumstances:
 - INSEARCH cancels the course;
 - the student produces written evidence that an application for a student visa has been rejected by the Australian government (this does not include where a student visa renewal is rejected or a student visa has been cancelled because of a breach of visa conditions); or
 - INSEARCH receives written notice of cancellation of enrolment from the student at least 28 days before the first day of the course. INSEARCH will retain 20% of the course fee paid if enrolment is cancelled by the student for reasons other than a rejection of a student visa application. Where less than a full work-load is to be undertaken and therefore less than a full semester fee is payable, the retained fee will be 20% of that fee.
 - Course fees will not be refunded if:
 - the student, enrolled in the course less than 28 days prior to the commencement of that course subsequently cancels the enrolment for reasons other than a rejection of a student visa application; or
 - the student arrives in Australia after the course has commenced.
- Applying for a refund**
 - Students wishing to apply for a refund need to apply in writing. Onshore students should complete an Application for refund of fees form available from the INSEARCH Student Services office and submit this to Student Service staff. Students who have not yet arrived in Australia should forward their written request for a refund to the Registrar.
- Termination**
 - INSEARCH reserves the right to expel a student for serious breach of discipline. Fees will not be refunded.
- Transfer of fees to other institutions**
 - A student who cancels his/her enrolment and who is not entitled to a refund of course fees may apply to the Registrar of INSEARCH for permission to transfer prepaid course fees to another INSEARCH course or an Australian university if the student has been formally admitted to a degree course of that university.
 - INSEARCH has absolute discretion in determining whether an application for the transfer of prepaid course fees will be approved. A transfer is subject to government regulations.
- If a transfer of prepaid course fees is approved, INSEARCH reserves the right to retain 20% of those fees to cover administrative costs.
- Grievance resolution**
 - INSEARCH has policies and procedures in place for the hearing of student difficulties and grievances. If you are not satisfied with the outcome, INSEARCH has an independent dispute resolution process available.
 - This agreement, and the availability of complaints and appeals processes, does not remove the right of the student to take action under Australia's consumer protection laws.
- Student Privacy**
 - INSEARCH acknowledges and respects the privacy of students. It is required under the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) to comply with the National Privacy Principles in respect of the collection, use and disclosure of personal information from individuals.
 - INSEARCH collects personal information from students for the purposes of processing applications and providing services to students. This information will be disclosed to INSEARCH, the student's agent and UTS where applicable.
 - INSEARCH has an obligation under Commonwealth and State legislation to provide information to certain government departments.
 - Provision of personal information is voluntary, but if it is not provided, INSEARCH may be unable to process the student's application.
 - Students have a right to access and alter their personal information.
