SOME ADVICE

Pocket money: To cover the cost of your lunch, travelling by bus each day, entertainment and other expenses, you should allow about **AUD300 - 350 a week.**

REGISTRATION FEE \$195 for all courses. Enrol for as long as you want. Part time is 3 hours a day, 08:45 to 11:45. Working Holiday and Visitor visas only.
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- Government regulations require holders of **Student visas** to attend **full time**.
- Holders of **Visitor visas** and **Working Holiday visas** can choose **full time** or **part time**. A useful website is www.immi.gov.au.
- **Working Holiday visas** are only available to nationals of **Belgium, Canada, Estonia, France, Germany, Holland, Hong Kong, Italy, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, Sweden, Denmark, Norway, and Finland**.
- The fees **do not include** textbooks, which cost from \$25 to \$55 (general English) and \$90 to \$170 (Cambridge courses).
- Overseas Student Health Cover (**OSHC**) is **compulsory** for holders of **Student visas** at the rate of **approximately \$36 a month**. Purchase of insurance before entering Australia for theft, loss, injury, illness and accident is recommended for **Visitor** and **Working Holiday** visas; for **Student** visas, only theft and loss is necessary.

REFUNDS and CANCELLATIONS. Section 7 of the **Education Services for Overseas Students Act 1991** ensures that the fees paid to Australian Colleges by overseas are safeguarded. Our refund policy is included in your letter of offer.
