# conditions of enrolment

By signing the Application Form the student (or where applicable a parent/guardian who has signed this contract) agrees to adhere to these Conditions of Enrolment and in return UNSW Global Pty Limited (UNSWG) (represented by UNSW Institute of Languages) agrees to provide the student with tuition in the relevant courses. Please note entry to the University English Entry Course (UEEC) or the Pre Foundation Year English course (PFY) are subject to eligibility placement tests on arrival.

#### Enrolment

- The student agrees to pay UNSWG the appropriate fee(s) as stated in the current prospectus / brochure.
- Students will not be permitted to commence their course until all fees or charges are paid and any eligibility placement tests have been successfully completed.
- The student agrees to abide by the rules and regulations as set out in the Student Handbook which will be supplied on arrival.
- An ELICOS course is 5 weeks in duration except in the case of the University English Entry Course (UEEC) and Pre Foundation Year (PFY) course which are 10 weeks in duration.

#### Satisfactory Attendance

- The student agrees to attend all classes unless prevented by a legitimate reason, e.g. illness, in which case a doctor's certificate should be presented if requested by UNSWG.
- The Australian Government Immigration Department insists that students on student visas attend 80% or more of their classes. Renewal of a student's visa depends on this.

#### **Student Welfare**

- The student agrees to authorise UNSWG to obtain medical treatment if required and to indemnify UNSWG for any expense, loss, damage or liability as a result of authorising emergency medical treatment.
- Parents/guardians of students under 18 years of age agree that students will have unsupervised access to the full internet and UNSWG will not be responsible for content that
  may be viewed on the internet.
- Parents/guardians of students under 18 years of age agree that students may attend occasional course-related and supervised excursions and field trips, or supervised sports activities, as part of the UNSWG programs.
- The student agrees that he/she is responsible for his/her own personal items including books and equipment and the student hereby releases UNSWG from all liability and claims for loss or damage to such items howsoever caused.

#### Withdrawal and Refund Policy

- The enrolment fee is non-refundable.
- The student is entitled to a full refund of tuition fees and other fees if his or her visa application is rejected. The student must notify UNSWG Student Services in writing within 28 days of receipt of rejection notice and supply evidence of rejection to receive the full refund.
- If the student cancels his or her course by written notice <u>more</u> than 28 days before the course commencement date, (for reasons other than his or her visa application was rejected), he or she will receive a refund of 75% of the tuition fees paid for that course plus any airport pick-up fee paid and any homestay placement fee paid if this service has not yet been provided.
- If the student cancels his or her course less than 28 days before the course commencement date or the course has commenced, the tuition fees, any airport pick-up fee or homestay placement fee will not be refunded.
- Fees paid, other than the enrolment fee and tuition fees, are subject to refund conditions of the providers of the relevant services.
- The student is not entitled to any refund of tuition or other fees if their enrolment is cancelled by UNSWG due to non-compliance with visa or enrolment conditions.
- Approved refunds will be made within four (4) weeks.
- If in the unlikely event UNSWG cancels a course, the student will be entitled to a full refund of the enrolment fee and tuition fee.
- This agreement and the availability of complaints and appeals processes do not remove the rights of the student to take further action under Australia's consumer protection laws.
- Any variation to this refund policy will be at the discretion of UNSWG.

## **Complaints and Appeals Policy**

- In the event of a dispute between an individual student and UNSWG relating to the code of conduct, attendance, quality of service or teaching, or the payment or refund of fees, procedures to facilitate the resolution of the dispute are outlined in the Student Handbook.
- UNSWG's dispute resolution processes do not circumscribe the student's right to pursue other legal remedies. For details refer to the National Code of the Education Services for Overseas Students (ESOS).

# **Privacy Policy**

- The UNSWG Privacy Policy has been developed to provide a clear and concise statement of how and when students' personal information is collected, stored and distributed by UNSWG. The Policy is available from the relevant course provider's website. Students can access personal information held by UNSWG, in accordance with the Commonwealth Privacy Act 1988. Consent is given to UNSWG using and disclosing personal details for the purpose of informing the Recruitment Representative or family of the student on progress during the course.
- The student agrees to authorise UNSWG to communicate to parents, guardians or sponsors, information in relation to enrolment, participation and progress in the program, including information regarding academic results, attendance and personal issues that may affect the well-being of the student.

#### Personal Information Collected

- Personal information may be shared with other sections of UNSWG, UNSW and, for placement purposes, with other education institutions. UNSWG undertakes not to sell, rent
  or trade personal information, and will not disclose information about a student unless:
  - the disclosure is required by law;
  - the disclosure is authorised by law;
  - consent has been given to our disclosing the information about a student through the acceptance of the terms and conditions of the program for which a student has applied; or
  - the disclosure is requested by Commonwealth or State agencies.

## Guardianship for International Students less than 18 years of age

- The Australian Commonwealth Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) has established special immigration requirements relating to the care of international students under age 18. The law specifies that the only person who may be nominated as a guardian or carer of an under 18 student is a relative of the student who is over 21 years of age with a police clearance to establish good character.
- If a student under 18 years of age cannot nominate a relative as a carer who is over 21 years and acceptable to DIAC, UNSWG will sign the Confirmation of Appropriate Accommodation and Welfare (CAAW) form required for student visa processing. The CAAW form confirms to DIAC that appropriate arrangements have been made for the student's accommodation, support and general welfare.
- Our Welfare and Accommodation staff will arrange suitable accommodation for students under the age of 18 and will meet regularly to discuss any concerns about accommodation, academic progress and any other personal issues that may be affecting their well being. If you require this service please request the CAAW form when completing your application. Please note that this service requires UNSWG to carry out extensive preliminary checks before issuing the CAAW and to monitor the student's care arrangements throughout the course. An additional fee is therefore charged.
